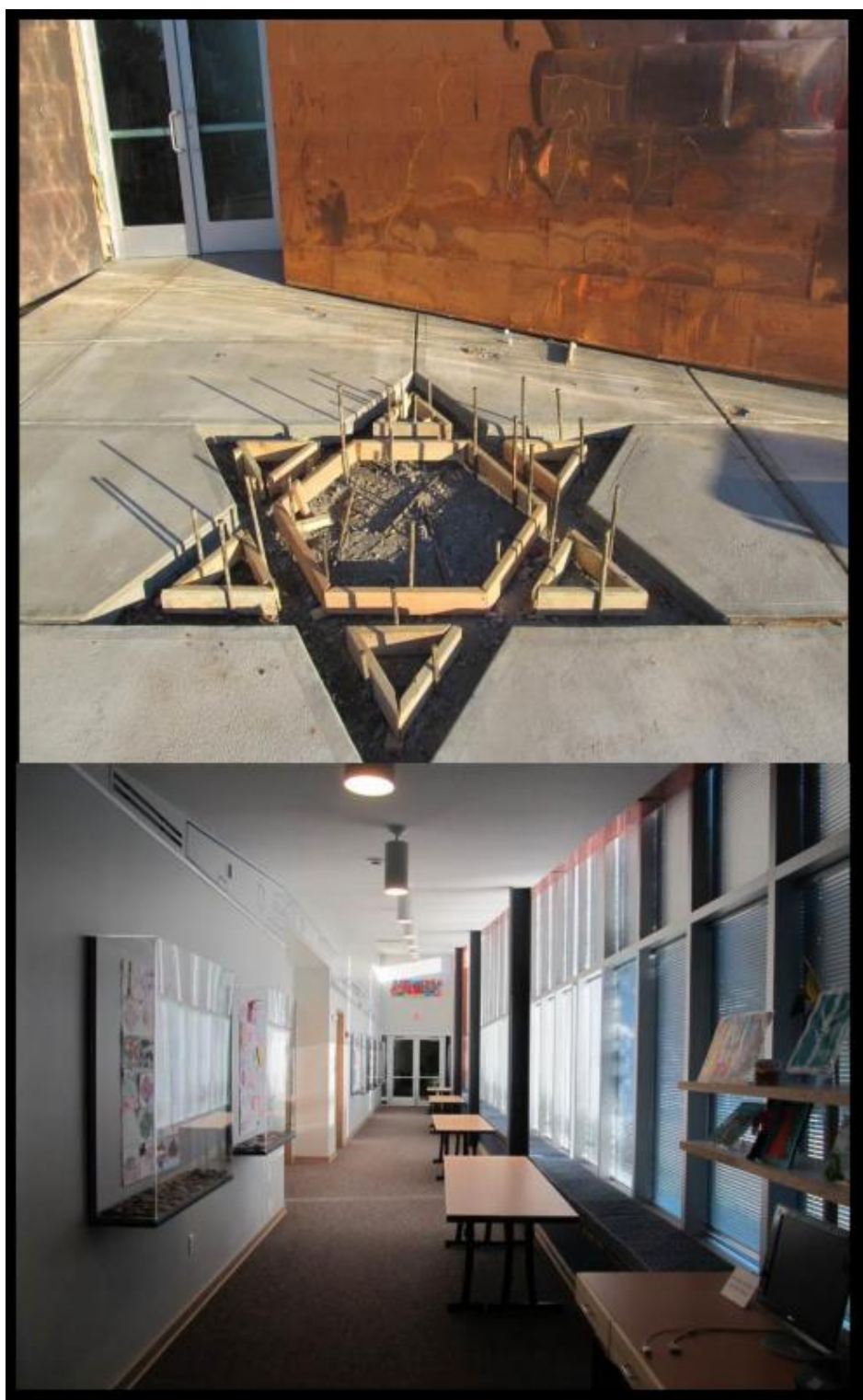

October 26, 2014 - January 31, 2015

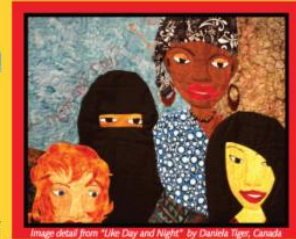
