## **A WEEK OF CINEMATIC DELIGHTS AT CIRCLE CINEMA AS THE THEATRE FEATURES OKLAHOMA'S FIRST JEWISH FILM FESTIVAL**

Local film buffs will gather October 19-23 at Circle Cinema (10 S. Lewis Ave) to enjoy a mix of foreign films, US documentaries, comedies, and dramas--all combined in a special collection offered as Tulsa's first ever Jewish film festival.

A collaboration of Circle Cinema, Jewish Federation of Tulsa, and The Sherwin Miller Museum of Jewish



Art, the event presents two films each night, the first beginning at 6pm--with the exception of the opening night starting at 5pm. Opening night includes a 6pm reception with special guest Michael Wallis of Route 66 fame to kick off the festival following the first feature, a UK comedy titled *Sixty-Six*.

Themed receptions will be offered during the festival including a special exhibition on the origins of comedy from The Sherwin Miller Museum of Jewish Art, to coincide with the screening of *When Comedy Went to School*, a US documentary on the birth of modern stand-up.

Additional offerings include the French drama, *For A Woman*, Ukrainian documentary, *Chicken Soup With Knives*, and back by popular demand, US documentary, *The Sturgeon Queens*.

The event is open to the public and tickets are available now at Circle Cinema, online at [www.circlecinema.com](http://www.circlecinema.com) or at the door. Tickets are \$10 per film; \$15 on opening night with reception.
